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**Overview of our Trustlands Plan from 2013-14:**

An important part of the Community Council's responsibilities is to develop our yearly plan to spend Trustlands Money.

Including funds carried over from the previous year, our Trustlands budget for 13-14 was \$33,646. Of that total, we spent \$28,951 with a carryover of \$4695. All monies spent were for personnel: our arts specialist, our take-home librarian, and our Homework Club teacher's assistant. These innovative and hard-working professionals were hired to help us improve our reading, math, and arts instruction programs.

**Overview of our Trustlands Plan for 2014-15:**

Including carryover, our funding for this year's plan will be \$30, 655. We plan to spend it in the exact same manner as last year: arts specialist, take-home librarian, and Homework Club teacher's assistant. The community council meets each March to develop this plan.
